AFTER COVID-19
RELATED ABSENCE

INDIVIDUAL HAD
CLOSE CONTACT WITH
SOMEONE WHO
TESTED POSITIVE



May return after:

14-day quarantine period
from date of last contact. *

*Close contact is defined as
within 6 ft. for 15 minutes or
more.

Contact of a contact does
not apply.

INDIVIDUAL TESTED
POSITIVE OR IS
SUSPECTED OF HAVING
COVID-19 AND HAD
SYMPTOMS



May return after:

1. At least 10 days have
passed since symptom
onset AND
2. At least 24 hours since
resolution of fever and
improvements of other
symptoms.

INDIVIDUAL TESTED
POSITIVE FOR COVID-19
BUT HAD NO
SYMPTOMS



May return after:

At least 10 days have
passed since date of
first positive COVID-
19 Test.

INDIVIDUAL EXHIBITS
ONE OR MORE
SYMPTOMS OF COVID-
19, BUT IS NOT
SUSPECTED OF HAVING
COVID-19



May return after:

1. At least 10 days have
passed since symptom
onset OR
2. Symptom and fever free
for 24 hours with
doctor's certification of
non-COVID illness.

Please keep your student home if they are ill. However, as per IDPH recommendations, we want to work closely with our parents and local Health Department to communicate any illness that is not COVID-19 related so that students may return to school before the 10 days if possible via physician's certification of non-COVID illness.
